EXTENSIONS AND CORRECTIONS TO THE UDC

NUMBER 29 – NOVEMBER 2007

Extensions and Corrections to the UDC is published annually, usually in November each year. It gives notice of the officially authorized changes to the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC), proposals for future change, contributions to the UDCC from interested parties on topics related to the UDC and other relevant information.

The latest version of the UDC is held in a database known as the Master Reference File (MRF), comprising approximately 67,000 entries, held by the Secretariat of the UDC Consortium in The Hague, (The Netherlands). A copy of the MRF is issued annually, usually in January each year, to UDCC Executive Members, Publishers and other authorized holders (licensees) of UDC editions.

Unless otherwise indicated, the MRF to be issued in January 2007 will incorporate the amendments notified in this edition of **Extensions and Corrections to the UDC**.

A primary responsibility of the *Stichting* UDC Consortium under its Articles of Association and Bye-laws is to maintain the UDC: this includes keeping it up to date through annual revision of the MRF, promulgating the results of research, maintenance and updating and taking account of user needs.

Publishers of UDC language editions make their own decisions about how and when to adopt any changes and are expected to identify which edition of the MRF has been used in their products.

Some publishers continue to maintain and publish UDC tables at levels of edition extended beyond the range of the MRF and they are responsible for deciding when and how to amend such versions.

The Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) is the intellectual property of the UDC Consortium.

The MRF is the only official source for the UDC.

The UDC Consortium is the only body that can authorize publication of the UDC in any language, in any form and via any media.

Any publication of the UDC, or of a part thereof, or of a derivation therefrom, requires the prior written consent of the UDC Consortium via an up to date licence.
