

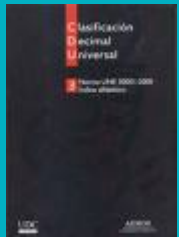

1. PRINTED UDC, 2000



- 1. PRINTED UDC edition in three volumes - the objective is to serve as the main Spanish UDC reference and application manual:
- VOLUME 1 - SYSTEMATIC TABLES (0 / 5) Contains the main tables from class 0 to class 5, and complete common auxiliary tables. 476 pages
- VOLUME 2 - SYSTEMATIC TABLES (6 / 9)
The volume includes the main tables from class 6 to class 9. 551 pages
- VOLUME 3 - ALPHABETICAL INDEX
Provides subject alphabetical index to the main and common auxiliary tables 75,13 €

2. UDC in CD-ROM, 2000

- UDC for the use in a computer environment
- CD-ROM, the **complete content of the printed UDC** edition with a powerful searching and browsing functions
- The interface is based on the hypertext technology combined with a good graphical support that results in a sophisticated navigation and browsing classification interface
- Allows easy positioning in the hierarchy and moving from one part of the schedules to another avoiding long browsing sequences

2.UDC in CD-ROM, 2000

- It is possible to retrieve an information associated with the expression or concept introduced by the user almost *instantaneously*
- It incorporates a "notebook of notes " for users to record commentaries, in order to keep track of the work carried out in each session.
- The program allows to users to the print a complete section or a selected part of the UDC schedule

2. UDC in CD-ROM, 2000

- The CDU in computer support is subject to license of use, which grants itself with character monouser and monoposition(monoplace), and does not have periodic update.

3. *Guide to the use of UDC*



- This book is an extension and total revision of I.C. McIlwaine's earlier book written in 1993. In the subsequent years much has happened with the classification
- The ammendements of the Spanish edition provided by R. San Segundo
- In particular, a much more rigorous approach has been undertaken in revision to ensure that the scheme is able to handle the requirements of a networked world

3. Guide to the use of UDC

- The book outlines the history and development of the UDC, provides practical hints on its application and explains auxiliary and main tables highlighting aspects that need to be taken into account in using the scheme.
- It also provides guidance on the use of the Master Reference File and discusses the ways in which the classification is used in the 21st century and its suitability as an aid to subject description in tagging metadata and consequently for application on the Internet.
- It is a source of information on the scheme, to practitioners classifying books and as a guide to students learning how to use the classification. It is abundant with examples illustrating many ways in which the scheme can be used and is a useful source to all information workers.

- Only for students, and for small libraries

- Prepared and adjusted by R. San Segundo
- Numbers that are not typically used in Spanish-speaking world were omitted. No alteration of structure, systematic order or notation were made.

- The appropriate format and ease of use made a "brief UDC " an indispensable tool for teaching and studying of UDC vocabulary
- This edition is also a tool of a great practical value to professionals working on documentation since it helps them in locating classification terms easily and quickly

4.UDC Abridged Edition, 2004



- The " brief UDC ", is aligned with the last Spanish edition of the UDC (Norma UNE 50001:2000 CDU) in 3 volumes, in order to support both practical classification work as well as classification training and education
- The elimination of terms in this new brief edition was conducted with a great care in order to preserve the structure, characteristics and organization of UDC

- The aim of the pocket edition is to allow a brief overview and quick access to the UDC terminology and structure and therefore, it complements UDC edition in three volumes and "brief UDC" edition thus helping in bibliographical work and professional education
- Because of its size, practical format and clarity of the presentation, pocket edition has become an essential reference book for UDC specialists but also an useful tool for use in small public libraries
- UDC pocket edition demonstrates fundamental characteristics of the UDC while avoiding terminology that is too specific or too technical for its targeted audience and purpose
- Similar to the "brief edition" , the pocket edition also contains: an alphabetical index, an explanatory introduction and provides numerous practical examples

6.UDC: THE FIRST NEW MODIFICATION

- The first new modification, for the Spanish UDC in 3 volumes (50001/1M:2004) provides the most important changes that have occurred in the UDC since 2000, such as:
 - common auxiliary table of properties
 - completely revised class 2 Religion
 - changes in: cinema, social welfare and environmental sciences
 - some important cancellations (e.g. 619 Veterinary science)
- This document constitutes an essential appendix to the UDC edition in three volumes.
- 61 pages, format: A4 8 Euros

7. Future UDC products

- Creation of an electronic edition of the UDC mapped to the subject heading system of the National Library of Madrid
- The head of this project: R. San Segundo
- Joint project of: the University Carlos III of Madrid, AENOR and Spanish National Library (Madrid)
- The results will be similar to
 - the mapping of the Dewey Decimal Classification to the LCSH that was available in the "Dewey for Windows" application
 - the mapping of Library of Congress Classification to LCSH, in the "LCC plus" application
- The main concern is to meet the deadlines and have the results as soon as possible
